A Solution for Economic Mobility

Foundational Math Skills

- 1. Predictor of later achievement in both math and reading¹
- 2. Required for high-school diploma (Algebra I), income opportunity²
- 3. Key to STEM career opportunities³
- 4. Tied to academic enthusiasm and confidence⁴

Hundreds of Weekly Mentors (980+ in 2017/18)

- 1. Decreases segregation in hyper-segregated schools
- 2. Increases flow of social capital through relationship-building
- 3. Promotes civic engagement⁵



Volunteers use Heart's tutor-friendly curriculum and are supported by an on-site coordinator.

- ▶SVP Partners pilot program, creating curriculum and assessments, principal relationships, and student results.


